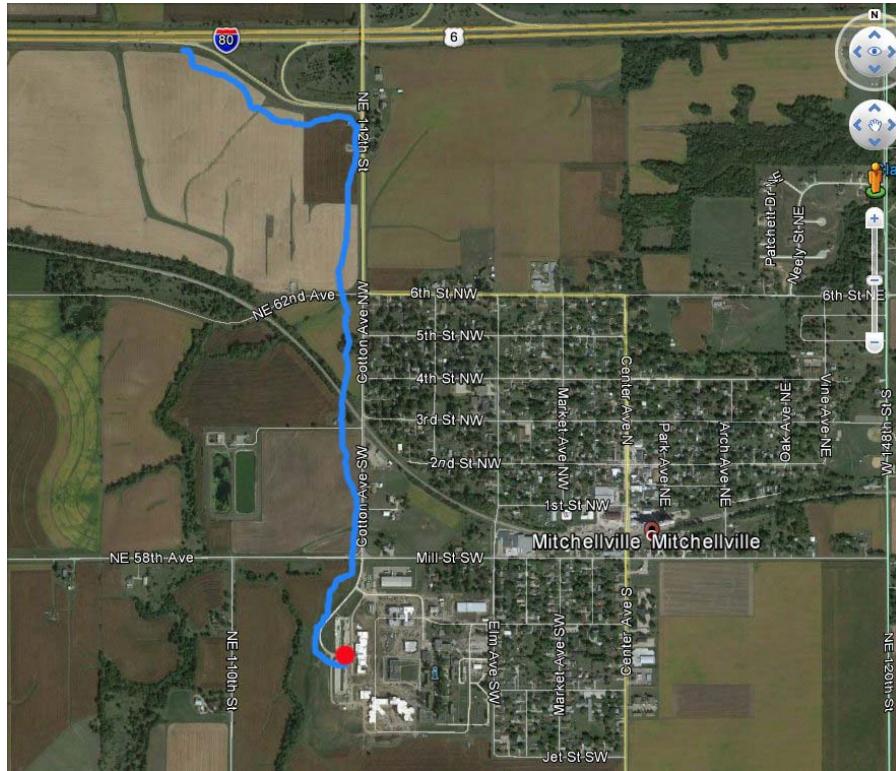
His group issues credit cards of the Visa variety. They are growing very quickly. In fact, they recently made the Fortune 500 list of fastest-growing companies.
