This \$64 million project involves several new (and much needed) buildings, state of the art technology and facilities designed with the latest in correctional methodologies in mind.

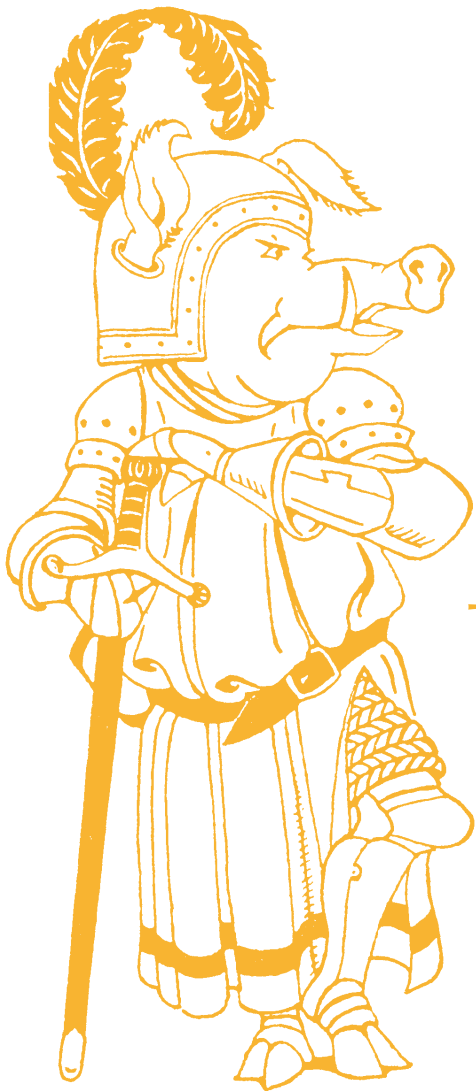

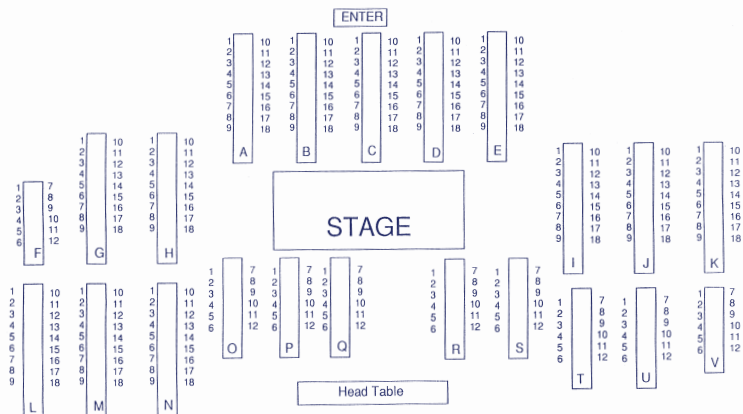
